Awarded a Gold Medal at the 1889 Paris EXPO




Winter rye variety 'Sangaste' is at present the oldest cultivated variety in the world

Versatile Count F. G. M von Berg

- Plant breeding potato variety 'Sangaste Topaz'
- Introduction of silage facilities (legumes and forage grasses)
- Group feeding of cows based on milk production rate, year-round indoor farming
- Centrifugal grain sifter and sorter (1st award EXPO 1893 Chicago)
- Construction of barn railway for feeding
- Introduction of 12-field crop rotation system
- Establishment of field tests of crop varieties
- Construction of machine milking system and mobile milk cooling machine
- Development of wooden potato harvester
